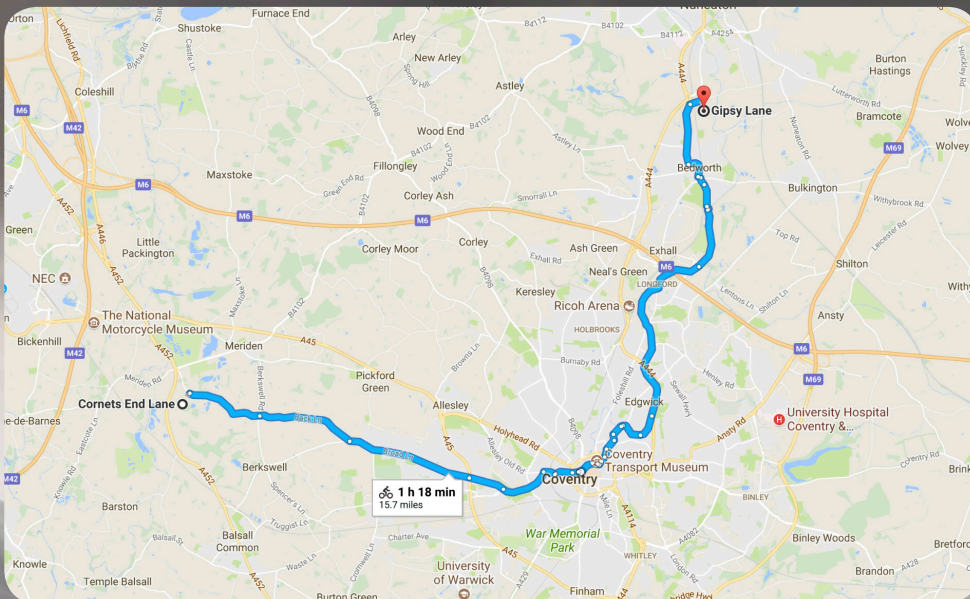




## FROM BERKSWELL QUARRY TO GRIFF QUARRY

1.3 mi	Head south-east on Cornets End Ln towards Mercote Hall Ln
1.6 mi	Continue onto Back Ln
2.1 mi	Turn left onto Broad Ln
0.6 mi	At the roundabout, continue straight to stay on Broad Ln
0.8 mi	At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto B4101
0.2 mi	Turn right onto Spon End/B4101
105 ft	Turn left onto Spon End
0.3 mi	Continue onto Upper Spon St
0.1 mi	Continue onto Spon St
249 ft	Continue onto Fleet St
0.2 mi	Turn left onto Corporation St
459 ft	Continue onto Hales St
148 ft	Slight left to stay on Hales St
259 ft	Turn left to stay on Hales St
39 ft	Turn left towards Bird St
0.1 mi	Slight right towards Bird St
7 ft	Slight left onto Bird St
0.1 mi	Turn right towards Stoney Stanton Rd

**Please ensure you do not enter onto any quarry site.**

Ensure follow all road markings and are aware of your surroundings.

Wear appropriate clothing and be prepared for changing weather conditions.

Only undertake the route if it is within your cycling and fitness capability and ensure you schedule in refreshment breaks in along the way.

Check all of your equipment is in good condition.

Environmental conditions can change the nature of the trails within a short space of time, you should only continue if safe to do so.

It's also a good idea to ensure you have a basic first aid kit with you.
